

SUPPLY LIST FOR 7th and 8th GRADE STUDENTS

Dear Parents and Students,

For the start of the 2019-20 school year, the 7/8 teachers would like to see the students bring in the following supplies in order to be prepared for all classes:

- **An agenda book of your choice** (the school will not provide one this year)
- **Six 1” binders (one for each subject listed below)**
 - ★ It is helpful to purchase different colored binders to color-code/organize your subjects. Some students like to have an additional 1” binder to house their agenda book, pencil pouch, and reading book that they bring to all classes.
- **Approximately 12 tabbed dividers (to be divided among all subjects).**
- **Loose-leaf paper for the binders—at least 2 packs for use throughout the year.**
- **A pencil pouch that contains pencils, colored pencils, colored sharpies, black and blue ink pens, small post-it notes, highlighters, eraser caps, white-out.**
- **Chromebook hard plastic cover or neoprene carrying case to fit 11.6 inch device**

The following list explains what you will need for each individual subject:

- 3 dividers for the binder labeled “Reading”, “Writing”, “Grammar/Vocab”. Include paper.
- Spiral bound notebook
- Index cards
- 1 folder with pockets to hold graded writing and literature assignments

- folder with 2 pockets (in the 1” binder)
- 1 set watercolor paints

- Loose-leaf paper
- Colored Pencils
- Highlighters

MATH: Mr. Gantenbein

- 1 spiral-bound notebook with at least 250 sheets (**7th Only**)
- 2 dividers in the binder labeled “Handouts” and “Homework”
- Colored pencils
- Ruler

- 2 tabbed dividers for the binder
- Pouch to hold flashcards
